Under Kennedy's leadership, the Product Compliance and Regulatory Affairs organization will focus on strengthening Cummins' collaboration with the environmental agencies that set emissions regulations and certification processes to ensure continued compliance with increasingly-challenging global emissions regulations. The new organization will function independently from, and provide oversight to, the product development teams and business units.

During the last six years, Kennedy has led various Cummins business markets. Most recently, Kennedy served as General Manager and Executive Director of the Pick-up Truck Business and prior to that she led the Rail and Defense business.

Before joining Cummins, Kennedy was a partner at the law firm of Baker & Daniels, where she led the firm's energy, environment and climate change practice group. There, she concentrated her practice on public finance, economic development, and environmental matters where she counseled numerous clients on complex matters. Kennedy has also worked in local government serving as deputy mayor for Indianapolis Mayor Bart Peterson.

Kennedy received her B.A. in Environmental Studies and History (1991), her M.S. in Environmental Science (1995) at the School of Public and Environmental Affairs (SPEA), and her J.D. from Indiana University, Bloomington (1995). She is active in her community and currently serves as President of the Capital Improvements Board, a member of the 2021 NBA All-Star Committee, and the Impact 100 Board of Directors. Kennedy lives with her family in Indianapolis.
